



Port of Corner Brook to Host IMPAC AGM & Conference

The Independent Marine Ports Association of Canada (IMPAC) will be holding its Annual General Meeting (AGM) and Professional Development Conference September 23-25, 2014 in Corner Brook, Newfoundland & Labrador. The official host of the conference is the Corner Brook Port Corporation.
