Cruise ship visit to Corner Brook cancelled for Monday, May 23

CORNER BROOK – Unfortunately, the first scheduled visit of the 2016 Corner Brook cruise season has been cancelled. The Boudicca, a ship from UK-based Fred Olsen Cruise Lines, was due to arrive in Corner Brook at 9 am on Monday, May 23. Due to high winds in Sydney, Nova Scotia today, the ship was unable to depart Sydney at 4 pm as scheduled. As a result, the ship will remain at the dock in Sydney overnight and will set sail from there mid-day tomorrow. The ship will be sailing across the Atlantic and back to the UK to conclude its Transatlantic itinerary which commenced on May 14.

Corner Brook Port Corporation is expecting 10 more cruise ship visits this season. The next scheduled call will be the Rotterdam (Holland America Line) on July 24. The remaining visits will occur in September and October. These include: Seabourn Quest (Seabourn) on September 5, the second call of the Boudicca on September 15, Marco Polo (Cruise & Maritime Voyages) on September 17, and Silver Whisper (Silver Sea) on September 19. The Oceania Regatta (Oceania Cruises) will make three visits, September 26, October 4 and October 7. The largest vessel of the season, the Caribbean Princess (Princess Cruises), will arrive on October 5 and the Phoenix Reisen ship Amadea will call on October 7.
