Corner Brook's Cruise Ship Season Resumes This Week

CORNER BROOK – Corner Brook Port Corporation has already hosted the first cruise ship of the season, the Oceania Marina, which docked on June 3 bringing more than 1,000 passengers to the Corner Brook area. The Port Corporation will welcome the second ship of the 2013 cruise season on Friday, August 23. The cruise ship Amadea will arrive in port at 12 p.m. and is scheduled to depart at 6 p.m. The ship, which made its debut in 2006 for Phoenix Reisen, has a capacity of 600 passengers and 250 crew.

Amadea is the flagship of the Phoenix Reisen Line and one of three ships that compose its fleet. Friday's visit will be the Amadea's inaugural call to Corner Brook Port. Some of the more unique offerings onboard the Amadea include a spacious garden and golf course landscape, a jogging track that wraps around the promenade, and first class quality cabins. Upon departure from Corner Brook, the vessel will cruise the Labrador Sea and then proceed to Greenland to continue its itinerary. The 25 Day Canada & Greenland itinerary began in Bremerhaven, Germany on August 12 and will conclude on September 6, 2013 as the Amadea returns to Bremerhaven.

Following the Amadea's call on August 23, the next scheduled call will be Monday, August 26 when the Astor from Transocean Cruises arrives. The Astor's last visit to Corner Brook Port was during the 2006 season. The vessel, which has a capacity of 578 passengers and 260 crew, will arrive at 9 a.m. and spend the day in port, departing at 6 p.m. on its 47 Day Greenland & Canada itinerary.

There are a total of 13 cruise ships scheduled to visit Corner Brook this season. The busiest part of the season will be September as seven cruise ships come to port, including the inaugural call of Royal Caribbean's Explorer of the Seas on September 16. The ship will visit Corner Brook twice this season, carrying with it over 3,000 passengers per visit.
